Clearwater County Council approved and finalized the Capital and Operations budget on December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Nordegg folks may find items of interest in the 2019 budget include:

- Construction of a new washroom near the playground
- Completion of Phase 1 in the modular home park.
- Reconstruction of Quarry Road.
- Preliminary engineering for the Nordegg Commercial Core
- Renovations to the Nordegg Museum
- Preservation of the Big Horn Store
- Looking into options to expand the parking lot of the Nordegg Community Hall
- Museum sanitary line replacement
- Golf Course Club House sanitary line installation
- Installation of sanitary dumping station
- Installation of addition streetlights.

As you may all be aware, the Provincial Government has put out a proposal for the Bighorn Backcountry. I have heard from several of my constituents and want to encourage you all to send me emails of your viewpoint(s) and or thoughts. I know some of you are wondering why our Council has not yet taken a stance or put out information on this very important issue. The reason being is because Council basically had no more information than the public. Our Council was not consulted, despite our efforts to meet with the minister. Clearwater County's Reeve and Deputy Reeve only had a 'heads up' of the announcement ½ hour prior to the announcement itself. Over the last couple of weeks,

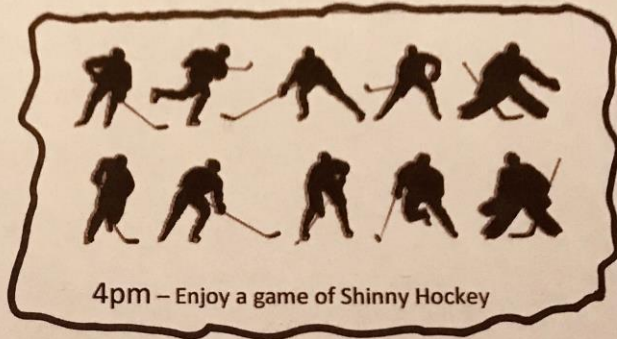
