Hello all,

There is and will be much happening in Nordegg.

As most of you know over the summer County staff has been working towards the creation of a public parking lot beside the Nordegg Hotel. Progress was hampered because of the weather but is now completed with remaining work having to do with final cleanup. This parking lot was created to enhance public parking availability in the area during fund raising events. The excess topsoil is being utilized by the community.

The County advertised for the sale and removal of the old log 'Beer Cabin', and my understanding is that a buyer has recently purchased it.

Public Works- The public works operations staff will be moving operations from the Old Blue Fire Hall to the new Public Works Operation Facility located in the industrial area west of Nordegg on the trunk road.

Manufactured Home Park- Minor cleanup and utility installation is still outstanding. Staff are obtaining quotes for a perimeter fence.

Nordegg Museum Public Washroom – Construction of a new public washroom adjacent to the Nordegg museum is scheduled to commence this fall.

Nordegg Golf Course will see the installation of a new sanitary line to tie the golf course to the sewer system.

Quarry Road – Reconstruction of this road was scheduled for this fall, but given the inclement weather this summer and the delayed progress on other projects this project may get delayed till 2020.

Historic Commercial Core – The tender for the construction of the Historic Commercial Core is scheduled for later this fall with construction scheduled to commence in 2020. This includes,

road construction, sanitary and water services, shallow utilities and a curb and gutter road design. Council voted in favour to my motion to have an open house in Nordegg prior to having 2nd and 3rd reading of the new mobile home park being presented to Council. This will be a great opportunity for the community to bring forth any comments, concerns and thoughts about the mobile park. The date will be advertised and I will do my best to also let the community know of the open house date.

Council and County staff will also be planning on having a second open house hopefully sometime in the spring or early next summer regarding future development in Nordegg. Once I know more, I will pass along more information.
